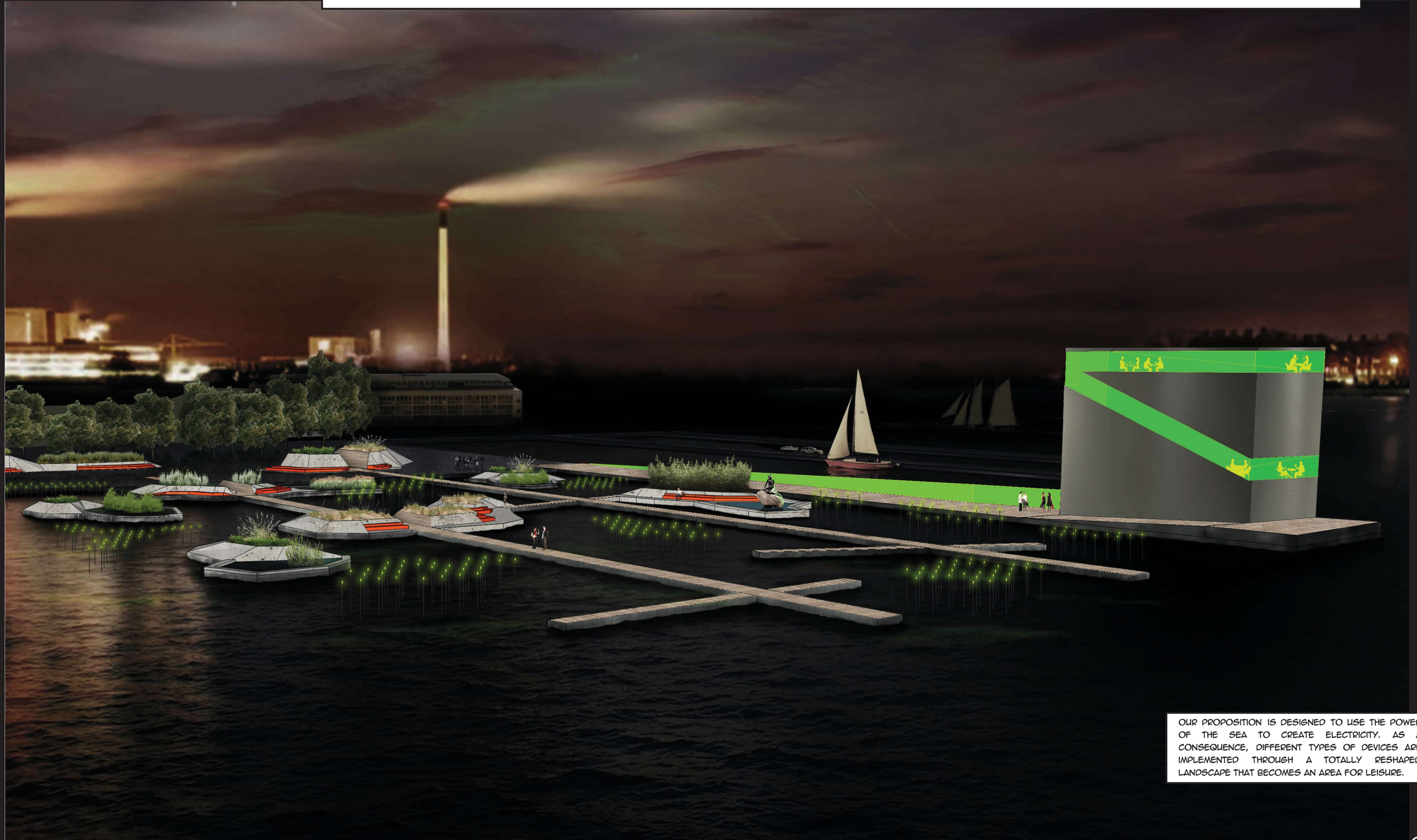


THE L&S 2014 DESIGN SITE IS AN OLD LANDFILL LOCATED AT THE NORTH END OF AMAGER ISLAND NAMED REFSHALEØEN. AS A PART OF COPENHAGEN HARBOUR, THE SITE USED TO BE HOME TO SHIPYARDS. THEREFORE, WATER IS A SIGNIFICANT FEATURE OF THE LANDSCAPE OF THE AREA. MOREOVER, BEING LOCATED RIGHT IN FRONT OF THE LANGE LINIE PROMENADE AT THE OTHER SIDE OF THE CHANNEL, REFSHALEØEN LAYS IN THE BACKGROUND OF THE LITTLE MERMAID STATUE. THOUGH IT USED TO BE AN INDUSTRIAL SITE, NOW REFSHALEØEN HAS BECOME A HOME TO CREATIVE START-UPS, SMALL CRAFT FACILITIES, FLEA MARKETS, LEISURE AND CULTURAL VENUES.



OUR PROPOSITION IS DESIGNED TO USE THE POWER OF THE SEA TO CREATE ELECTRICITY. AS A CONSEQUENCE, DIFFERENT TYPES OF DEVICES ARE IMPLEMENTED THROUGH A TOTALLY RESHAPED LANDSCAPE THAT BECOMES AN AREA FOR LEISURE.
