



The conceptual salls are technically tensed conductive nets supported on several masts or posts. The generation occurs on pieces of cloth attached to this grid. But the net itself is a regular grid composed of loose electrical conductors inside flexible plastic tubes; being the latter the ones that are truly subjected to the structural tension.

An agreeable and dynamic space is generated underneath the sails, as a result of the disposition variation in altitude, size and orientation. On top of that, the movement of both the sails as a whole and the small pieces that conform it, transforms the space continuously offering a unique experience every moment.
