'Ø' is a green Island in the center of Copenhagen harbor. It is an outdoor amphitheater and park, which is able of producing energy for own consumption and extra energy for the surrounding city. The approximately 4000 m<sup>2</sup> solar panels can produce 600 kWp and have an annual production of 620,000 kW/h, equivalent to 100 households.

'Ø' is a realistic project, based on simple and proven technology. It is a social gathering concept that calls for shared experiences. It is a green island for trips and picnics. It is also a scene for both organized and spontaneous concerts, theater and perhaps sports in the open air. It will literally be a space full of energy.

'Ø' appears graphically distinct and is easily recognized from the air and on city maps. The island is circular and the line crossing it and defining it as the Danish letter Ø is also the access line to the facility. The line pointing to the Little Mermaid starts as an 8 -meter-wide connection from the quay, goes through the 'earthwork' structure, onwards through the amphitheater and ends as a jetty for the water bus.
