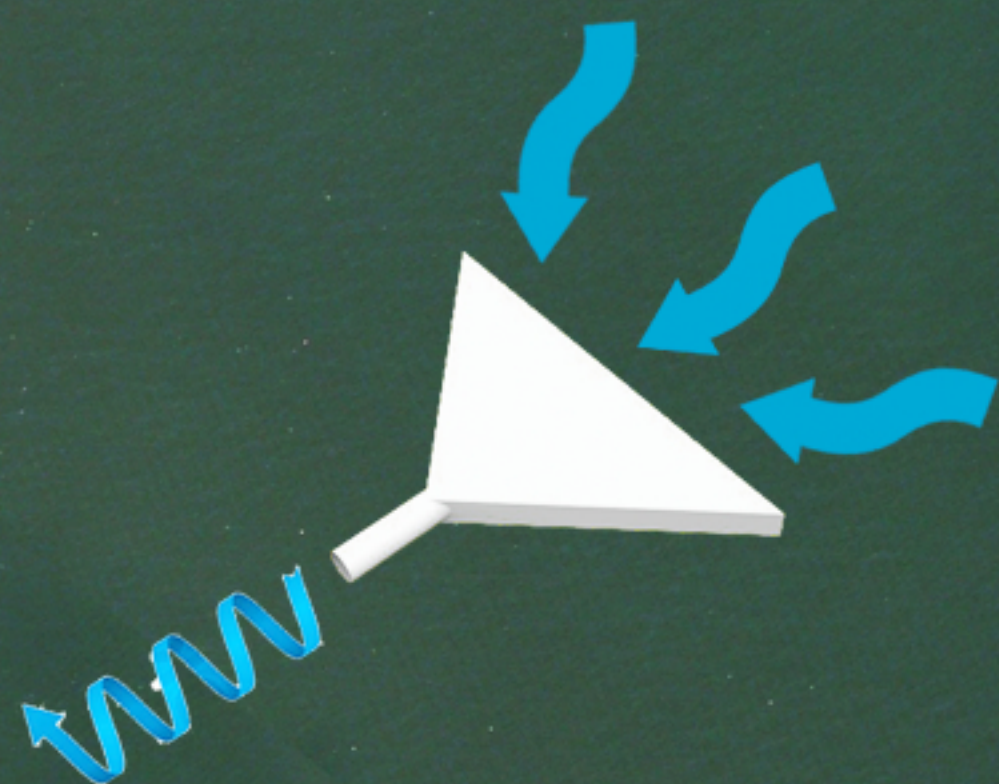


CANYON

Most of Denmark is on equal elevations. The country has beautiful plains, beaches, scenic views. It also has a remarkably clean ocean but the ocean is only accessible for a few short months each year. I propose giving the people of Denmark something new. I designed a multilevel, undulating landscape. In the center of the terrain is a carved out canal that lets in fresh ocean water but is heated first. Pipes are also imbedded within each layer of concrete to make the outdoors more accessible during the cold winter months.

The contours the landscape were designed by first taking line graphs of Denmark's climate and world pollution levels.



The park is powered by hundreds of small turbines. The concrete slabs have large cone shaped voids milled into them to funnel air toward the turbines to create more wind power.
