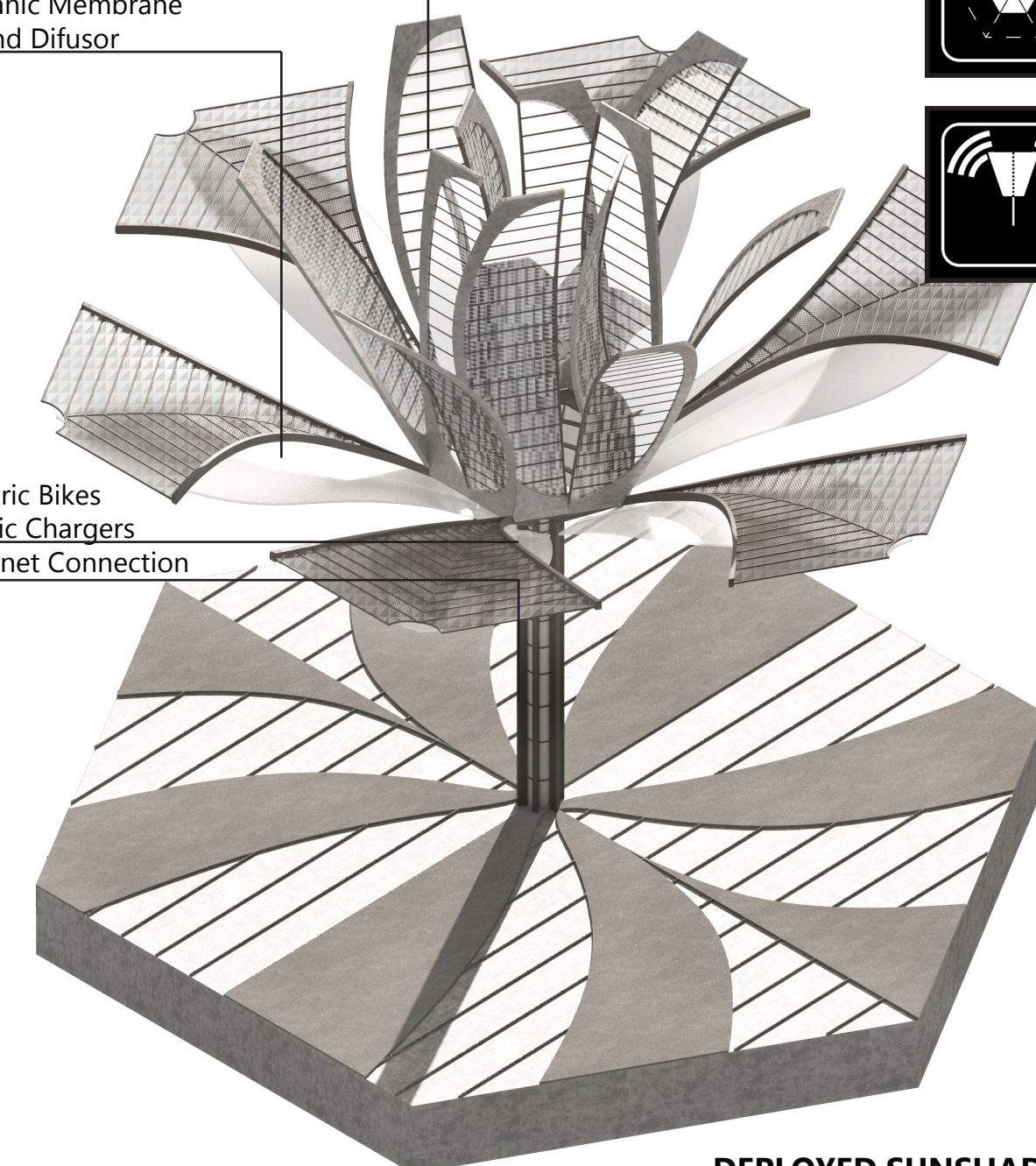

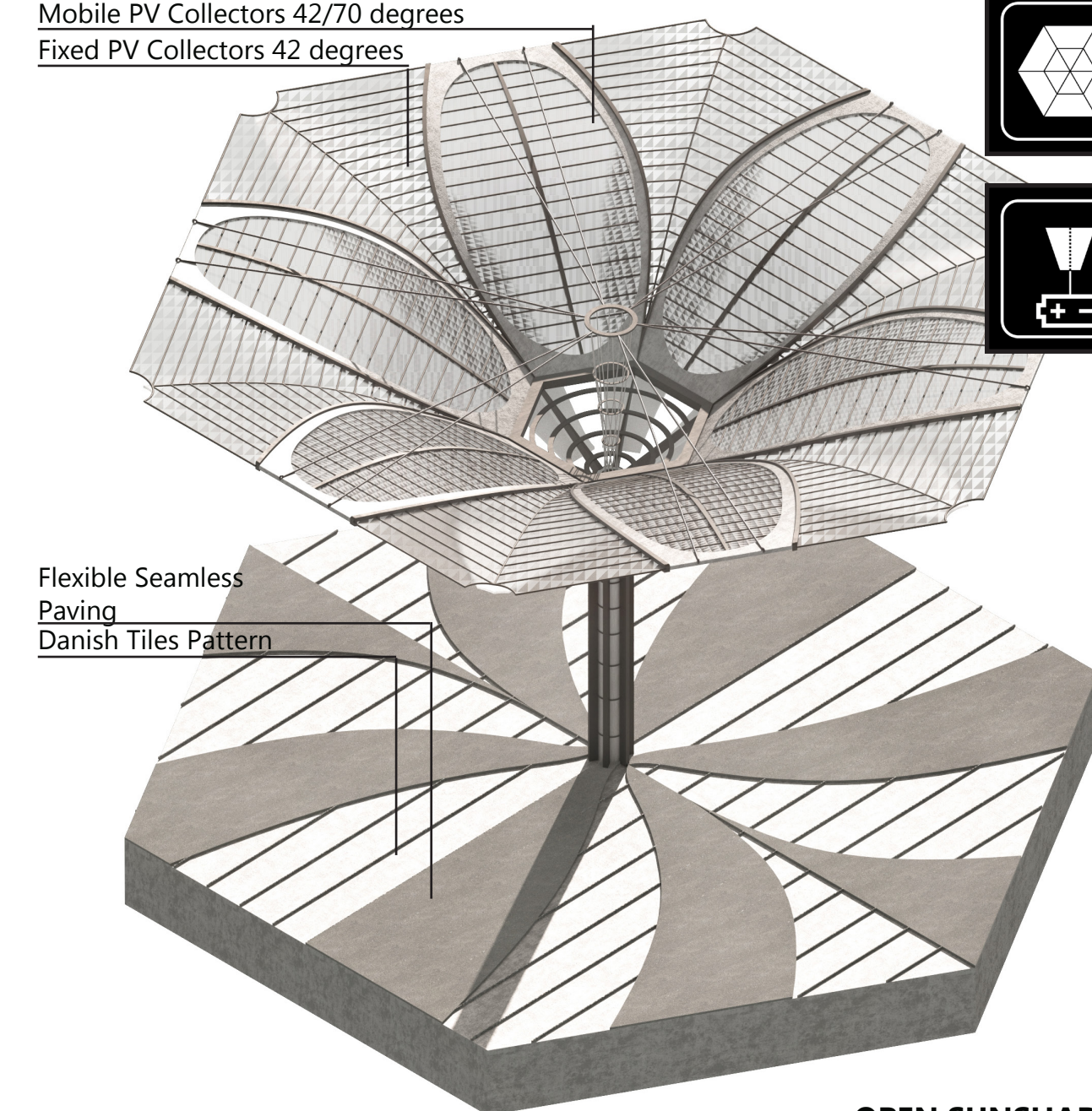

OPEN SUNSHADERS

The solar-shades closes like a flower permitting the project exist in two different states. During the day, the retractable arms are open permitting the maximum solar energy harvesting and creating a soft continuity in the space providing a 65 percent of shadowing under and making possible host all kind of temporary activities, concerts, festivals, private events, and exhibitions or public demonstrations.

On the night or special events when the solar energy harvesting and the shade are not an issue the sunshades, measuring each nearly 6m in diameter can be quickly deployed using a simple and solar-powered hydraulic system.

On that way the pavillion permite the full spatial experience change, transforming the intervention area from a covered public space to an open air park in just minutes, opening the views towards the canals and creating a recognizable new interactive mediated outdoor space that emitted a diffuse soft lighting helped by the reflecting surfaces of the energy collectors, giving an impressive and unique ephemeral iconographic image that is going to turn the place into an iconic Copenhagen spot bringing new live to some unused urban voids on the harbor area and the surrounding.
