




The Symbiotic Island



The orientation of the structures benefit from the sunlight conditions, having photovoltaic modules arrayed within the 'roof' of the sculptures. These sculptures offer a permeable space both for the natural world and the visitors, forging a generative agency between man and environment. The sculptures are spaces within a landscape which allow the public to explore.
